Friendship House History

The Friendship House was opened in 2001 with funds from the South Central Community Based Initiative.

The Initiative is a program funded by the MN Department of Human Services to develop mental health outreach programs that provide support, crisis intervention, and self help skill training teaching, consumer advocacy and problem solving to reduce and/or eliminate hospitalizations.

To also develop recreational activities and outings, as well as work support that assist consumers in their efforts to function successfully in the community.

Services Available at Friendship House:
