- Staff and Program are flexible and accommodating to client needs

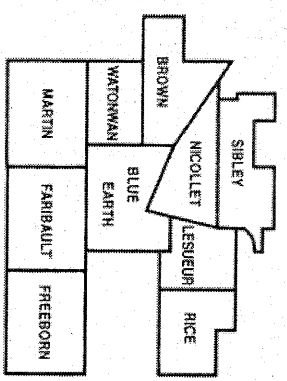

Residential Sub Acute Care:

- Clients are not accepted on self-referral
- Referrals may be asked to present for further assessment before being admitted
- Must be referred by:
 - Hospitals
 - Law Enforcement
 - Mental Health Provider
 - Primary Care Provider
 - Case Managers
- 10 Bed Facility
- 24 Hour Supervision
- Short term stay
- Coordination of Community Services

Crisis Assessment,

Intervention and Education available on a residential and outpatient basis:

- Diagnostic Assessments
- Medication Adjustments
- Individual treatment planning along with educational groups
- Services are based on mental health issues being a primary concern

Psychiatric Urgent Care:

- Medication Adjustments
- Diagnostic Evaluations
- Interim psychiatric care until clients can follow up in the community

Criteria for Services:

- Must be 18 years old
- Clients must reside in the South Central Community Based Initiative 10 County area: Blue Earth, Brown, Faribault, Freeborn, Le Sueur, Martin, Nicollet, Rice, Sibley and Watonwan
- Crisis Center will accept referrals for voluntary admission and emergency hold orders if they meet criteria.
